The Timm's Hill National Trail is a 10 mile non-motorized trail connecting the Ice Age National Scenic Trail to Timm's Hill, elevation 1951.5 feet, Wisconsin's highest natural point.

Permitted Uses

The trail is open year round for hiking, mountain biking, skiing, and snowshoeing. Skis or snowshoes are required on the groomed trail in the winter.

Note: The southern 2 miles of the trail is open January 1st thru August 31st. Please follow Hwy C from September 1st thru December 31st.

Except for the Timm's Hill County Park, the entire trail is on private property. The landowners have graciously allowed the trail to cross their property, so it's very important that all trail users respect the trail and the property it crosses.

Access

Parking is available at the southern terminus on County Hwy C in Taylor County and at the northern terminus in Timm's Hill County Park in Price County.

Winter Sports

The entire trail is groomed for cross country skiing and snowshoeing. The southern portion of the trail is relatively flat, but gets progressively hillier on the northern portion of the trail.

There are also groomed trail systems at both the northern and southern terminus of the Timm's Hill Trail.

Facilities

At the southern terminus there's a picnic area and rustic campsites.

At the northern terminus, the Timm's Hill County Park features a beach, picnic area, shelter, pit toilets, and an observation tower.

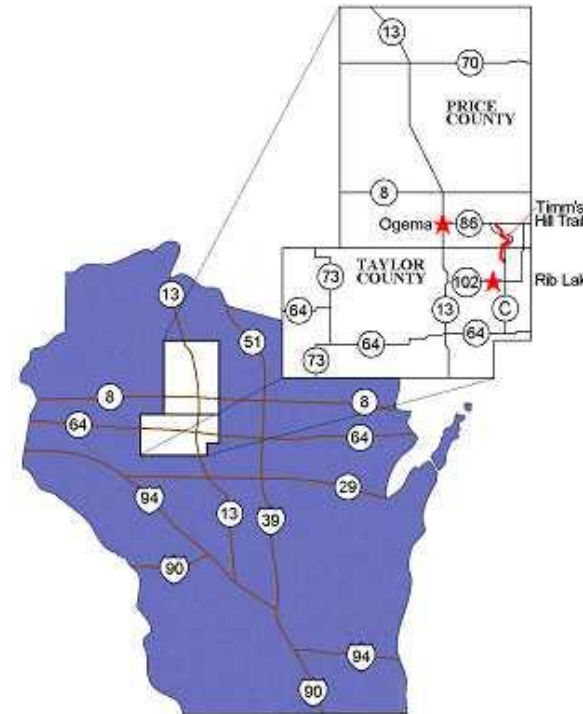
Giving Back
